Reporting Event Requirements: Contact us as soon as possible if a worker:

Is taken from or leaves the jobsite for treatment at a medical facility; Misses time from work after the day of the injury; Loses consciousness; Is diagnosed with a work-related disease; Develops symptoms of a mental health disorder related to work or the work environment; Suffers broken eyeglasses, dentures, hearing aid or artificial limb due to a work-related incident. Employers must also immediately report serious incidents and fatalities to us by calling the Prevention Information Line. This is in addition to reporting an injury related to a

Reporting Event Requirements: Submit a report to WCB if the accident results in, or is likely to result in:

lost time or the need to temporarily or permanently modify work beyond the date of accident; death or permanent disability (amputation, hearing loss, etc.); a disabling or potentially disabling disease or condition caused by occupational exposure or activity (such as a mental health concern, poisoning, infection, respiratory disease, dermatitis etc.); the need for medical or mental health treatment beyond first aid (assessment by physician, psychologist or mental health provider, physiotherapist, chiropractor, etc.); or incurring medical aid expenses (dental treatment, eyeglass repair or replacement, prescription medications, etc.)

Reporting Event Requirements:

Requirements

- 1. The worker loses consciousness following the accident, or
- 2. The worker is transported, or directed by a first aid attendant or other representative of the employer to a hospital or other place of medical treatment, or is recommended by such person to go to such place, or
- 3. The injury is one that obviously requires medical treatment, or
- 4. The worker states that he / she intends to seek medical treatment, or
- 5. The worker has received medical treatment for the injury, or
- 6. The worker is unable or claims to be unable by reason of the injury to return to his or her usual job function on any working day subsequent to the day of the injury, or
- 7. An injury resulted or is claimed to have resulted in the breakage of an artificial limb, eyeglasses, contact lenses, dentures, hearing aid, or any other prosthetic device, or
- 8. The WCB has requested that an employer forwards a report of the accident resulting in an injury or occupational disease to the WCB, or the worker has filed a claim.

Reporting Event Requirements: Employers must report a work-related accident to the WSIB if they learn that a worker requires health care and/or is absent from regular work; earns less than regular pay for regular work (e.g., part-time hours); requires modified work at less than regular pay or requires modified work at regular pay for more than seven calendar days following the date of accident.

This includes injuries or illnesses that occurred over a period of time, as well as those caused by a single event. A workplace injury or illness is considered to be one that happens at work; requires medical treatment; may or may not result in time off work.

- the worker has suffered a total or partial loss of a limb or its use or a significant trauma
- several workers have been injured and must be absent from work for more than one working day
- the accident caused property damage of \$150,000 or more

Reporting Event Requirements: Notify WorkSafeNB IMMEDIATELY to report the following incidents:

A loss of consciousness; Amputations; Fractures (other than fingers or toes); Burns requiring medical attention beyond first aid treatment; Loss of vision in one or both eyes; Deep lacerations requiring medical attention beyond first aid treatment; Worker admission to a hospital as an inpatient; Fatalities; Any accidental explosion or exposure to a biological, chemical or physical agent, whether or not a person is injured; Any catastrophic event or equipment failure that results, or could have resulted in an injury

Reporting Event Requirements: Report a fatality immediately.

Report a **serious injury** as soon as possible, within 24 hours: Unconsciousness; Fracture of the skull, spine, pelvis, arm, leg, ankle, wrist or a major part of the hand or foot; Loss or amputation of a leg, arm, hand, foot, finger, or toe; Third-degree burn; Loss of sight in one or both eyes; Asphyxiation or poisoning; Any injury that requires admission to hospital; Any injury that endangers life.

Report a **serious incident** as soon as possible, within 24 hours: An accidental explosion; A major structural failure or collapse of a building or other structure; A major release of a hazardous substance; A fall from a work area where fall protection is required by the regulations.
